- Centrally fabricated braces (ex Generation II, Donjoy, Breg, Omni) (orthotics)

- Closed Caption Television System (hearing aid)
- Commodes or Commode Chairs
- Cough assist machines
- CTI knee brace (orthotics)
- Dental/oral appliances for treatment of obstructive sleep apnea (OSA)
- Dentures (maxillofacial)
- Dialysis Equipment
- Environmental Control Units
- Donjoy knee brace (orthotics)
- Fracture braces (orthotics)
- Generation II knee brace (orthotics)
- Grab bars
- High-frequency chest wall oscillation airway clearance device
- Home renovations (including ramps, porch lifts, etc.)

- Humidifier – stand alone

- Medication pumps (ex.TPN) (medical supplies)
- Night-time-use-only braces (ex Charleston) (orthotics)
- Non-wheeled Walkers
- Obus form (positioning aids)

- Oral splints for TMJ (maxillofacial)
- Orthopaedic shoes (even custom made) and Modifications (orthotics)
- Ostomy supplies for temporary ostomies
- Peak flow metre (respiratory)
- Post-operative support braces (orthotics)
- Pre-fabricated braces (anything off the shelf) (orthotics)
- Raised toilet seats
- Most rental of equipment (see respiratory category for apnea monitor rental)
- Repairs to any ADP funded items excluding equipment from Ventilator Equipment Pool
- Replacement masks, headgear, etc. for CPAP machines
- Shoe inserts (orthotics)
- Spirometers (including micro-spirometer)
- Stair Glides
- Stethoscopes
- Standard walking canes (mobility)
- Stimulating devices
- Stockings for varicose veins or venous insufficiency (pressure modification devices)
- Talking clocks and calculators (communication/visual aids)
- Telephones – regular and adaptive
- TENS machine
- Total parenteral nutrition (TPN) pumps and supplies
- Transport chair (wheelchairs)
- Treatment machines (ex. TENS, Continuous Passive Motion (CPM)) (orthotics)
